

Section 4.8 Raw Data

Question 4.8 asked “Are you affected by the lack of a particular health provision? If so, what additional services do you feel are needed?”

A total of 152 replies were made to the question broken down between wards as follows.

Of these 32 (21%) were for better transport, and a further 41 (27%) were from residents of Rode Heath wanting their own local GP.

Of the remaining 99 replies, the most called for provisions was a Dentist – 19, and More doctors/Longer hours, also with 19 replies.
